JOB MARKET PAPER SUMMARY

Export Quality and International Trade: A Theoretical and Empirical Analysis (Supervised by Dr. Sajal Lahiri)

This study explores the impact of a high-quality and a low-quality export product on the exports of a developing country. I developed a theoretical framework, using the two-country partial equilibrium oligopolistic model when one of the countries (developing country) exports both a low-quality and a high-quality good to a country which also produces the highest quality good (developed country). I then test the theoretical findings empirically using a panel dataset for 142 countries from 1963 - 2014 and by applying the gravity model of trade. This study also reinforces the argument that export quality matters to capture international market however, quality only matters for international trade but not domestic trade. The results indicate that quality has a positive impact on international trade and a 1% increase in quality leads to an increase in total exports by 1.08%. A 1% increase in quality leads to a fall in intranational trade by 2.69%. The results remain robust when different estimation techniques are used. This study also discusses the policy measures that developing countries should take to compete effectively in the international market and break the cycle of over-reliance on low-quality export goods and achieve higher economic growth.
